On the contrary, data collection was processed so that persons with impairments could participate. For instance, persons with hearing impairments contacted by phone could contact a hotline by email to highlight their difficulties and they could be transferred to the face to face data collection process or use a proxy. However, interviewers at the phone or in face to face could indicate that interview was impossible due to the difficulties of the sampled person understanding the survey. Therefore, even if no population has been excluded, the response rate of persons with impairments is</p>
